

Axmouth Village Hall Management Committee

This year has been very successful with a long list of social events that have been well attended. This is partly due to the collaboration with the Friends of Axmouth Church who jointly run some of the fund raising events.

Financially the accounts are healthy, showing that the village Hall is approximately £300 more in profit than this time last year. This is even more impressive, given that the kitchen has been refurbished and is now far more functional and efficient. Grants from EDDC (£1500), Cllr Jim Knight's locality grant (£1000), Axmouth Parish Council's grant (£500) and the Village Hall (£1500) all helped to fund the kitchen project.

The panelling around the base of the wall is completed in the main hall and will be started in the committee room in due course. Volunteers are working on this project and thanks to Morag and Ken Steven and Alan Coomber are duly given.

We also thank Mike Clement for his hard work over many years as he is standing down from the committee. David Dumbleton has joined the committee and has already organised his first event, a successful quiz evening.
