It seems pretty definite that extreme weather events can now be expected more regularly. That could mean disruptive flooding (Axmouth has been hit in recent years), storm damage and extended periods of snow and ice. Emergency services would respond to any of the above but, in future, if they are delayed or even overwhelmed by demand, your Parish Council feels it would be wise to have a special Emergencies Plan. This Plan would enable us to co-ordinate with each other and with the emergency services and not to be caught 'flat-footed' in a major event. More details are provided on following pages but, first and foremost, for emergencies large and small, the official services should be contacted. Here is a full list.

# THE AXMOUTH EMERGENCIES PLAN

Here are examples of some of the events where the Axmouth Emergencies Plan could augment and help the official emergency services.

Flooding Extended duration of snow & ice Extended duration of power cuts Fallen trees

Heart attack and use of the village defibrillator

Your council cannot predict what sort of emergency may occur but, if the emergency services do not arrive within a reasonable time to deal with it, the Plan will be activated. Villagers have volunteered to be wardens for this scheme and their contact details follow.

How villagers should contact wardens to ask for help or to offer help...

First, make contact with any warden on the list in your area. If all are unavailable, try the wardens in any other area. Initial contacts by landline, please, then, as the situation develops and wardens are out and about, contacts by mobiles will be necessary.

Once wardens and villagers get involved in an emergency, calls to communicate should be kept as brief as possible.

If the Plan is not activated but villagers feel that wardens could provide help that emergency services cannot provide, wardens may be able to assist as a community service.

Should outlying areas of the parish such as AXMOUTH HARBOUR, DOWLANDS, BOSHILL AND STEDCOMBE need emergency assistance—just call any warden on the list.

Within the circumstances of the Plan ONLY, the Parish Council would like to know of the availability of any equipment in the village (i.e. chain saws, ladders, tractors) and volunteers to use them.

To minimise danger and confusion in an emergency, villagers may be asked by wardens to stay within their property unless asked by a warden to assist.

In the event of accident and/or inadvertent damage, area wardens and anyone assisting will be covered by the Council's insurance.

The Plan tries to be forward-thinking but should not be expected to cover all events and unforeseen circumstances. It will be reviewed every year.

Have you thought about taking precautions against flood in your house? Maybe I ft. or 2 ft. high, tight-fitting boards on your exterior doors?

Mobile phone – kept well-charged.

Non-cordless phone (will work in power cut)

Battery or wind-up radio.

Warm/wet weather gear. Camping gas stove.

Torches and lanterns. 'Pusher' snow shovel
