Axmouth Parish Council currently has two councillor vacancies

Parish Councils depends on local people taking an interest in what happens in their community, whatever their background, and local people standing as councillors can bring a wealth of knowledge and community understanding into the local team.

What to Parish Councillors do? - They represent the community at monthly meetings on such issues as:

- **Planning** – new housing and applications for changes to buildings, which are overseen by East Devon District Council;
- **Highways, footpaths and rights of way** – liaising with Devon County Council, which is responsible for these and their maintenance;
- **Our natural environment** – we have a duty to conserve the bio-diversity of our beautiful landscape;
- **Seats, shelters, noticeboards, the phone box, the green and the viewing platform at Coronation Corner** – we keep an eye on, and maintain these.

Parish councillors should live in the parish and must be registered on the East Devon District Council Register of Electors within the Axmouth Parish. Training and support will be provided, but basic computer skills are necessary.
